

ST. JOHNS COUNTY
RESOLUTION NO. 87-72

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Department of Transportation is in the process of designing a replacement for the Matanzas Bridge on State Road A-1-A; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation is in the process of holding public hearings on the location and design configuration for the structure; and,

WHEREAS, the public hearings have resulted in requests for the D.O.T. to consider alternatives to the proposed structure including provisions for opening the Matanzas river entrance to larger vessels; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County hereby declares its unanimous opposition to the following:

1. Any increase in the height of the bridge, or any substantial change in the length of approach ramps.
2. Any plans requiring future construction or maintenance dredging the inlet.
3. Any plans requiring future construction of jetties, breakwaters, or similar structures at the inlet.

BE IT RESOLVED, FURTHER that St. Johns County hereby requests the D.O.T. to conduct said hearings at the County seat, and offers the St. Johns County Administration Building for all future hearings.
