NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, the Board authorizes the County Administrator to purchase one (1) used Mobile X-Ray and required accessory equipment in the amount of \$9,500.00 from Kings X-Ray Supply Corporation, Jacksonville, Florida, as provided in Florida Law 81-843, paragraph (c) when the goods, supplies, or materials are used or damaged.

As you may already know, I have been requested by police agencies and the prosecutor's offices to have X-ray capability in the proposed new medical examiner facility. In line with this request, I have been in contact with Mr. Glen Green of King's X-ray Supply Corp. of Jacksonville who would be able to supply the portable X-ray unit (used) that would be needed as well as darkroom equipment. 
