

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY

RESOLUTION NO. 88-247

WHEREAS, Seychelles Development Co. Inc
and
Nathaniel Curtis Jr, as Owner, ~~has~~ ^{have} applied
to the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida,
for approval to record a subdivision plat known as
Seychelles Replat and,

WHEREAS, the Owner and Mortgagee have dedicated certain roads,
streets, easements, rights-of-way or other areas as shown on the
subdivision plat for the uses and purposes thereon stated,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The above-described subdivision plat is conditionally
approved by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County,
Florida, subject to Section #6.

Section 2. The dedicated roads, streets, easements, rights-of-way
and other areas shown on the plat are conditionally accepted by the
Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County on behalf of the
beneficiaries to the dedication. This acceptance shall not be deemed
an acceptance requiring construction or maintenance of the roads,
streets, easements, rights-of-way or other areas by the County. This
acceptance is subject to Section #6.

Section 3. The Construction Bond ~~is waived.~~

*shall be the same as for
the original plat*

Section 4. The Warranty Bond is waived.

Section 5. The Clerk is instructed to file the title opened.

Section 6. The approval and acceptance described in Sections
1 and 2 shall not take effect until the plat has been signed by each
of the following departments, persons or offices:

- a) Chairman or Vice-Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida
- b) County Attorney
- c) County Planning Department or Office
- d) County Zoning Department or Office
- e) Clerk of Courts

The Clerk shall not sign or accept the plat for recording until it has been signed by each of the above persons or entities described in a) through d) above and the construction bond unless waived, has been delivered to the Clerk. If the plat is not signed and accepted by the Clerk for recording within 14 days from the date hereof, then the above-described conditional approval and acceptances shall automatically terminate. If the plat is signed by the Clerk on or before such time, the conditions described herein, shall be deemed to have occurred.
