

RESOLUTION NO. 88-263

WHEREAS, on September 22, 1988 the St. Johns County Director of Data Processing in a meeting with the County Administrator advised him that the impending move of the Data Processing Department must take place on a three day weekend of November 11 thru 13th, 1988, and

WHEREAS, the target date of November 10, 1988, for completion of all work related to the installation of the necessary cabling and equipment for Data Processing must be completed on the above date, and

WHEREAS, the time required is not sufficient to advertise for seal bids, evaluate bids, award contract and allow time for the contractor to order the necessary materials and equipment, schedule and complete installation of same by the target date, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners recognizes an emergency exists and sets aside the requirement for sealed bidding as provided in Chapter 81-483, paragraph (e), Laws of Florida and authorizes the County Administrator to obtain three proposals from qualified firms for providing the necessary material and equipment in accordance with the specifications and time allocated, to prepare and complete installation of the Data Processing equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Administrator be authorized, after receipt and evaluation of at least two proposals, to accept the proposal from the firm that can satisfy all the requirements, however, said proposal shall not exceed the total amount of \$62,000.00.
