RESOLUTION 88-277

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR THE PAVING OF A TWENTY-THIRD STREET AND A PORTION OF LAUREL STREET UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE 76-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, has received and accepted the petition of at least 60% of the landowners fronting on the abovementioned streets. The residents desire to have Twenty-third Street and a portion of Laurel Street paved pursuant to County Ordinance 76-21.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

- The petition is hereby accepted and the project is authorized to commence.
- 2. The beginning and ending points are from the west right-of-way line of AlA, running west on Twenty-third street to Laurel Street then continuing north on Laurel Street to the south right-of-way line of Twenty-first Street.
- The estimated cost of the project is \$60,000.00
- 4. The sharing ratio shall be as follows:

St. Johns County, one third of the cost The balance to be paid by the abutting landowners based on their proportionate share of road frontage.

- The preliminary assessment rate is \$9.75 per front foot.
- 6. The interest rate shall be 9.0 percent per annum and shall commence to accrue on the date that will be established by the County resolution determining the final assessment.
- 7. The term of payment shall be in cash or by check to be paid prior to commencement of construction. The owner may elect to pay over a five year period with 20% plus interest due at each annual payment.
- 8. Annual payments shall commence on the date that will be established by the County resolution determining the final assessment.
- S. Bring pal and accrued interest may be prepaid at any time without penalty.
