

RESOLUTION NO. 88-28

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners passed a Resolution No. 87-244 dated November 10, 1987, declaring an emergency existed for replacement of Miranda Road Bridge No: 784037 and,

WHEREAS, no mention was made in the above said Resolution No. 87-244 for authorization for the erection of the replacement bridge, and,

WHEREAS, the County Administrator recognizes that an emergency exists to replace the said bridge and recommends that the sixth and seventh paragraphs of Resolution No. 87-244 be revised to read:

WHEREAS, this Board finds in accordance with Chapter 81-483 2(e) Laws of Florida that procurement and erection of a replacement bridge is needed to alleviate an existing emergency, and that such procurement and bridge erection cannot be obtained in sufficient time if bids, public notice and advertisement are required,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that speedy replacement and erection of the County Bridge No. 784037 is declared a matter of public welfare and need and an emergency requiring suspension of normal bidding requirements, that the County Public Works Department is directed to proceed with the procurement and erection of a replacement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 87-244 is hereby revised.
