Subject to the following conditions:

- 1. This right of use is non-exclusive.
- 2. The single family driveway within County Right-of-Way must be privately maintained by the homeowner at all times. St. Johns County will assume no responsibility for maintenance of this use.
- 3. The owner of the above described property and any future owners must remove and/or relocate the driveway at their expense at the County's request at any time in the future.
