NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners together with the citizens of St. Johns County do hereby:


1. Commend Senator Mattox Hair for his many contributions to St. Johns County during his tenure in the Florida Legislature;
