

RESOLUTION NO. 88- 40

WHEREAS, the traffic control mechanism which controls the traffic lights located at State Road #312 and Coke Road, St. Johns County, has been rendered inoperable due to a traffic accident, and

WHEREAS, the said traffic control mechanism has recently been inspected by professional engineers and declared unsafe without replacement of the mechanism, and

WHEREAS, the most prudent course of action according to the professional engineers appears to be complete replacement, and

WHEREAS, the said control of traffic is vitally needed for motor vehicle and public safety in that area, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, A. This Board finds in accordance with Chapter 81-483 2(e) Laws of Florida that procurement of a replacement traffic control mechanism is needed to alleviate an existing emergency, and that such procurement cannot be obtained in sufficient time if bids, public notice and advertisements are required and,

B. Speedy replacement of the traffic control mechanism at State Road #312 and Coke Road is declared a matter of public welfare and need and an emergency requiring suspension of normal bidding requirements, that the County Public Works Department is directed to proceed with the procurement of a replacement without advertising and public bids.
