

RESOLUTION NO. 88-67

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT ST. JOHNS COUNTY ROAD PROGRAM HAS NO FUNDS TO IMPROVE INDUSTRIAL CENTER ROAD TO MEET STATE D.O.T. STANDARDS AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO APPLY FOR AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN ST. JOHNS COUNTY AND THE DIVISION OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT BY THE DIVISION OF \$200,000 TO THE COUNTY TO BE APPLIED TOWARD THE IMPROVEMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF APPROXIMATELY 2,000 FEET OF ROADWAY SOUTH FROM STATE ROAD 16 TO SERVE THE U.P.S. FACILITY, INCLUDING MODIFICATIONS AT STATE ROAD 16 TO PROVIDE SAFE ASSESS; ACCEPTANCE BY THE COUNTY OF FUTURE MAINTENANCE AND OTHER ATTENDANT COSTS OCCURRING AFTER COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT FOR THE PORTION OF THE PROJECT ON THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM; IN THE EVENT OF TERMINATION, A RETURN OF FUNDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 11 OF THE AGREEMENT SHALL BE PROMPTLY ACCOMPLISHED BY THE COUNTY.
