

RESOLUTION NO. 88-74

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA RELATING TO THE STATE ROAD 312 EXTENSION; PROVIDING FINDINGS AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE A LIMITED AND CONTROLLED ACCESS HIGHWAY; PROVIDING THAT SIGNALIZATION OF SUCH HIGHWAY SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SPECIFICATIONS; REQUIRING PROPERTY OWNERS ADJACENT TO INTERSECTIONS TO DEPOSIT WITH THE COUNTY MONEYS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF ANY INTERSECTION SERVING SUCH PROPERTY TOGETHER WITH SIGNALIZATION PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION OF SUCH INTERSECTIONS; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS THERETO; DIRECTING THE CLERK TO PUBLISH THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there has now been filed with the Board of County Commissioners a plan showing the line of construction for the extension of State Road 312 between its intersection with State Road 207 and its intersection with State Road 5, U. S. Highway No. 1, prepared by Connelly & Wicker, Inc., Consulting Engineers, Jacksonville Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that the designation of such highway as a limited and controlled access highway in accordance with plans and specifications for such highway prepared by Connelly & Wicker, Inc., Consulting Engineers, Jacksonville Beach, Florida would best promote the objectives set forth in the Manual of Uniform Minimum Standards for Design, Construction and Maintenance for Streets and Highways; and

WHEREAS, such line of construction is wholly outside the boundaries of any incorporated municipality; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statutes 338.01, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida is authorized by approving resolution to designate such highway as a limited access highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

Section 1. That the above findings are true.

Section 2. That the State Road 312 extension at its intersection with State Road 207 and State Road 5, U. S. Highway No. 1, between Stations 0+00 and Station 52+74, in accordance with the construction plans prepared by Connelly & Wicker, Inc., Consulting Engineers, Jacksonville Beach, Florida, is hereby designated as a limited and controlled access highway in accordance with such construction plans.

Section 3. Signalization for an intersection shown on such construction plans as prepared by Connelly & Wicker, Inc., Consulting Engineers, Jacksonville Beach, Florida shall be in accordance with St. Johns County criteria and State of Florida Department of Transportation specifications.

Section 4. That upon the deposit with the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida of sufficient funds to be provided by property owners for the construction of such intersections, turn lanes and such signalization, authorization is given for such construction and installation but, except as to extensions heretofore authorized by Contracts entered into between St. Johns County and adjacent property owners for acquisition of necessary rights-of-way, no such installation or construction will proceed until the deposit of such funds. If such funds are not deposited prior to completion of design, the applicant will be responsible for design of improvements, obtaining County and Florida Department of Transportation permits for construction, advertising for construction, employing a contractor to install improvements, repaving of

the A Lane Section of State Road 312 effected, payments to contractor and testing of work. The applicant shall obtain approval of Final Construction from the County and Florida Department of Transportation. During the construction period, applicant shall post a security Bond equal to 115% of estimated construction value.

Section 5. That this Resolution shall take effect fifteen (15) days following publication in a newspaper of general circulation within St. Johns County, Florida of this Resolution in accordance with the provisions of Florida Statutes 338.01(3).

Section 6. That the Clerk of Circuit Court for St. Johns County, ex officio Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners, St. Johns County, Florida be, and he is hereby, directed to cause publication of this Resolution as provided in Florida Statutes 338.01(3) (1987).
