

RESOLUTION NO. 89-122

COMMENDING ST. JOHNS COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES
ST. JOHNS COUNTY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT #5
AND THE CITY OF ST. AUGUSTINE FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, on May 15, 1989, while responding to an emergency, a city policeman (Walter Makowski) who, in order to avoid hitting a woman in a van who had pulled out in front of him, hit the old Security Federal Bank Building head-on, at 55 mph, and

WHEREAS, the victim was trapped in the wreckage for one hour and twenty minutes during which time he was stabilized by the following: 2 intravenous infusions, cervical immobilization, oxygen and cardiac monitor, and

WHEREAS, EMS personnel held his neck in one position for the entire time until he was freed from the wreckage and was transported by ambulance to Francis Field where the Life Flight helicopter picked him up and transported him to Baptist Medical Center for evaluation and surgery, and


WHEREAS, St. Johns County EMS personnel Captain Bobby Hall, EMT-P, Margo Stevens, RN, EMT-P, Phil Bors, EMT-P and Kenny Krulish, EMT, were involved in treating and extricating the victim from the wreckage as well as members of St. Johns County Volunteer Fire Department #5 and members of the City of St. Augustine Fire Department who responded and assisted in extricating the victim, and

WHEREAS, the EMS personnel, members of St. Johns County Volunteer Department #5, and the City of St. Augustine Fire Department reacted with speed and professionalism in providing immediate emergency treatment and stabilization to the patient until such time as he could be extricated from the wreckage through the combined efforts of all of the personnel involved


