

RESOLUTION NO. 89-234

A RESOLUTION OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, INCREASING THE FEE FOR WHICH THE HRS/ST. JOHNS COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH UNIT MAY CHARGE FOR BACTERIOLOGICAL ANALYSIS OF WATER.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Ordinance No. 82-2 authorized St. Johns County Public Health Unit to collect reasonable fees, contributions and donations for certain services performed by the Public Health Unit upon approval of such fee by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the fee of \$2.00 per household/system (up to three samples) to provide bacteriological water analysis on private wells no longer covers the cost of providing the service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 24th day of October, 1989, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that Resolution #88- is hereby amended by changing the Fee Schedule attached to said resolution to require \$5.00 for Bacteriological Water Testing instead of \$2.00.

All other provisions of St. Johns County Resolution 88- , as previously amended shall remain in full force and effect.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
