BOARD \mathtt{THE} RESOLUTION BYCOMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA STATING ITS INTENT TO USE THE UNIFORM METHOD COLLECTING NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS 197.3632) ASSESSED STATUTES (FLORIDA TO ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE PURSUANT NON EXEMPT RESIDENTIAL 89-20 AGAINST PROPERTIES LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF THE COUNTY TO FUND THE COSTS, SERVICE, PROVIDING, \mathbf{OF} DEBT INCLUDING OPERATING, MAINTAINING AND CLOSING SUFFICIENT OR PORTIONS OF COUNTY PARTS AVAILABLE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE THAT IS, OR CAN BE REASONABLY ANTICIPATED TO BE, PRODUCED OR GENERATED AT SUCH NON EXEMPT RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. For the reasons set forth in St. Johns County ordinance 89-20 there is a need for the levy and collection of a Special Assessment against Non Exempt Residential Properties located within the unincorporated areas of St. Johns County, Florida to fund the costs, including debt service, of providing, operating, maintaining and closing sufficient parts or portions of County Landfills available for the disposal of Residential Solid Waste that is, or can reasonably be anticipated to be, produced or generated at such Non Exempt Residential Property. (Capitalized terms herein have the same meanings as in St. Johns County ordinance 89-20.)

Section 2. The boundaries of the real property subject to the levy of the Special Assessments referred to herein are the boundaries of the unincorporated area of St. Johns County, Florida; such area consisting of the lands described in Florida Statute 7.58 less the lands contained within the corporate boundaries of (i) the City of St. Augustine, (ii) the City of St. Augustine Beach, (iii) the Town of Hastings, and (iv) that portion of the Town of Marineland located within St. Johns County.

Section 3. It is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida to use the Uniform Method Of Collecting Non-Ad Valorem Assessements (Florida Statute 197.3632) assessed pursuant to St. Johns County ordinance 89-20 against Non Exempt Residential Properties located within the unincorporated area of St. Johns County, Florida to fund the costs, including debt service, of providing, operating, maintaining and closing sufficient parts or portions of County Landfills available for the disposal of Residential Solid Waste that is, or can reasonably be anticipated to be, produced or generated at such Non Exempt Residential Property. (Capitalized terms herein have the same meanings as in St. Johns County ordinance 89-20.)
