

RESOLUTION NO. 89- 249

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPOINTING A ST. JOHNS COUNTY COMMISSIONER TO SERVE ON THE PUBLIC DEFENDERS CONFLICT COMMITTEE FOR THE SEVENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, appropriations have been made by the State of Florida to provide a fund to defray the costs of attorneys appointed to represent indigent defendants when there is a conflict within the Public Defender's Office; and,

WHEREAS, it is required that one member of each Board of County Commissioners within each judicial circuit be appointed to serve on a committee to establish a qualified list of attorneys to represent such indigent defendants; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County has been requested by the Chief Judge of the Seventh Judicial Circuit to appoint one of its members to serve on such a committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. County Commissioner Craig Maguire is hereby designated to serve as the St. Johns County Commission representative on the Public Defender Conflict Committee for the Seventh Judicial Circuit.

Section 2. A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded immediately to the Chief Judge of the Seventh Judicial Circuit.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
