WHEREAS, the County Detention Center serves as a housing unit for detention of prisoners for the Sheriff's Department of St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, the prison population has increased dramatically since the construction of the present detention facility four (4) years ago; and

WHEREAS, this increase has also impacted the Sewage Disposal System with various uncompatible materials, such as, shirts, sheets and other miscellaneous materials not intended for disposal into the City of St. Augustine's Lift Station; and

WHEREAS, this increase in prison population has created a situation wherein the Sewage Disposal System cannot provide adequate waste disposal of the type intended; and

WHEREAS, A Mechanical Waste Grinder is required immediately to alleviate the above conditions and the County received a price of \$22,500.00 to provide the required Waste Grinder.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Administrator to contract with Heyward Incorporated at a price not to exceed \$22,500.00 to have manufactured and installed a Waste Grinder System for the County Detention Center and, as provided in Florida Law 81-843 paragraph (e), the Board hereby finds and determines that the supplies or materials are needed to alleviate an existing emergency and that such goods, supplies and materials cannot be obtained in sufficient time if bids, public notice and advertisement are required.
