

RESOLUTION NO. 89-272

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE LAND ACQUISITION EFFORTS OF THE ST. JOHNS RIVER WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT; URGING AND REQUESTING THE ST. JOHNS RIVER WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT TO DESIGNATE AS ITS TOP PRIORITY, LAND ACQUISITION IN THE LOWER ST. JOHNS RIVER BASIN, THE JULINGTON/DURBIN CREEK PENINSULA

WHEREAS, the St. Johns River Water Management District, as part of the District Strategic Land Acquisition Plan, is engaged in acquiring property in order to preserve lands that produce high water resource and related environmental benefits, and to facilitate the restoration of altered systems from which such benefits have been lost; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners recognizes that the Julington/Durbin Creek Peninsula, now privately owned, is property which is of water management significance for St. Johns County and is of critical importance in maintaining the water quality of the St. Johns River,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby endorses and supports the efforts of the St. Johns River Water Management District in its efforts to acquire lands which are of environmental and water management significance.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby urges and requests the St. Johns River Water Management District to designate as its top priority, land acquisition in the Lower St. Johns River Basin, the Julington/Durbin Creek Peninsula.
