RESOLUTION 89- 277

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR THE PAVING OF A PORTION OF SEGOVIA ROAD UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE 76-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, has received and accepted the petition of at least 60% of the landowners fronting on the above mentioned street. The residents desire to have that portion of Segovia Road paved pursuant to County Ordinance 76-21.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

- 1. The petition is hereby accepted and the project is authorized to commence.
- 2. The beginning and ending points are from Miranda Road to Tolomato Road.
- 3. The estimated cost of the project is \$36,360.
- 4. The sharing ratio shall be as follows: St. Johns County, one third of the cost and the balance to be paid by the abutting landowners based on their proportionate share of road frontage.
- 5. The preliminary assessment rate is \$12.00 per front foot.
- 6. The interest rate shall be 9.0 percent per annum and shall commence to accrue on the date that will be established by the County resolution determining the final assessment.
- 7. The term of payment shall be in cash or by check to be paid prior to commencement of construction. The owner may elect to pay over a five year period with 20% plus interest due at each annual payment.
- 8. Annual payments shall commence on the date that will be established by the County resolution determining the final assessment.
- 9. Principal and accrued interest may be prepaid at any time without penalty.
