**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS FOR ST. JOHNS COUNTY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GRANT PROGRAMS ESTABLISHED BY THE SOLID WASTE ACT, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 1988.**

**WHEREAS, The Solid Waste Department of St. Johns County has since December 7, 1988, maintained a pilot program for the collection of Used Oil Recycling, and**

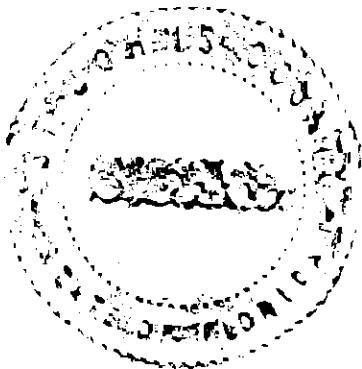
**WHEREAS, St. Johns County is desirous of continuing this pilot program and expresses its intent by seeking support funding made available under the Used Oil Recycling Grant Program Rule, Chapter 17-720 Florida Administrative Code, and**

**WHEREAS, The Solid Waste Department of St. Johns County has established a pilot program of 7,000 households to commence on February 13, 1989, for the purposes of recycling glass, aluminum, newspapers and white goods. The recycling program is a positive step by St. Johns County to meet the legal requirements for landfill operations addressed by the Florida legislature in The Solid Waste Act, and**

**WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Department of Environmental Regulations Bureau of Waste Planning and Regulations will make available an as yet undetermined amount of funds to St. Johns County to assist in achieving the above mentioned programs,**

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that St. Johns County supports and gives approval to the County Administrator and The Solid Waste Department to submit applications for St. Johns County under the Grants Program of The Solid Waste Act of 1988.**
