### LOCATION MAP






AMENDMENT TO BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT TRUST FUND LEASE NUMBER 3024 THIS LEASE AMENDMENT is entered into this 28th.day of \_\_\_\_, 1988, by and between the BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT TRUST FUND OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA (hereinafter referred to as the LESSOR) and ST. JOHNS COUNTY (hereinafter referred to as the LESSEE); WITNESSETH WHEREAS, the LESSOR, by virtue of Section 253.03, Florida Statutes, holds title to certain lands and property for the use and benefit of the State of Florida; and WHEREAS, on June 6, 1978, the LESSOR and the LESSEE entered into Lease No. 3024, for the use of certain land in St. Johns County, known as Butler State Park, for outdoor recreation, park, conservation and other public purposes. WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to modify and amend the Lease Agreement in order to extend the term of the lease from twenty-five years to fifty years from the date of the original agreement, dated June 6, 1978; and to authorize the St. Johns County Fire District to utilize 1.8 acres, more or less, of the land for a fire station site.
