NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 28th day of August , 1990, by the Board of County

Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that commencing

October 1, 1990, the St. Johns County Public Health Unit

shall charge pursuant to St. Johns County Ordinance #82-2,

as amended, the fees set forth in the attached fee schedule

for the services indicated therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the St. Johns County
Public Health Unit shall cause the funds derived from such
fees to be deposited promptly into the special revenue fund
described in St. Johns County Ordinance #82-2, and said
funds shall be used as provided in said Ordinance, but only
after the expenditures have been approved by the Board of
County Commissioners when such prior approval is required by
law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all prior resolutions establishing fees under and pursuant to Ordinance #82-2, as amended are hereby terminated.


