

RESOLUTION NO. 90-156

PROCLAMATION DESIGNATING AUGUST 27 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 3, 1990
AS NATIONAL JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ALUMNI WEEK

WHEREAS, the federally funded Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) is an effective program for assisting school dropouts, welfare recipients, unskilled adults, displaced homemakers, dislocated workers and others who face serious barriers to employment;

WHEREAS, the members of Congress, the members of the Florida Legislature, the press and our community should be informed of the positive impact JTPA has on the lives of our fellow citizens;

WHEREAS, all the partners in the JTPA system (federal, state, and local governments, business, labor, education, community-based organizations and service providers) must assume an active role in effectively communicating the success of the program;

WHEREAS, JTPA Alumni (individuals who have successfully completed the program) who have overcome their barriers to employment and are now productive members of our community are the best advocates for the program;
