

RESOLUTION NO. 90-162

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY GOLF COURSE FOR A TOURNAMENT.

WHEREAS, to promote the St. Johns County Golf Course and to introduce tourists to one of the finest municipal golf courses in northeast Florida; and

WHEREAS, to benefit the public at large, including visitors, to St. Johns County, by providing a public golf course to be utilized for a reasonable fee; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman and the Board of County Commissioners will formally dedicate the St. Johns County Golf Club House and establish their annual Championship Golf Tournament to be called "The St. Johns,"

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, hereby authorizes the use of the St. Johns County Golf Course for a tournament to be held on Saturday and Sunday, November 3 & 4, 1990, or a later date, if weather intervenes, at the fees outlined in the attached "Exhibit A." A portion of the entry fees will be placed in a special trust account for the promotion of Junior Golf events and/or other improvements to be made to the St. Johns County Golf Course.

THE TOURNAMENT WILL BE NAMED, AT YOUR PLEASURE, **"THE ST. JOHNS"** IN ORDER TO HONOR THE BOARD, THE COUNTY AND ALL THE VENUE UPON WHICH THE TOURNAMENT IS ORIGINATING AND ASSUREDLY WILL EXPAND EACH YEAR. THE FORMAT IS DEVISED TO INTEREST PLAYERS FROM AREAS OUTSIDE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY AND PROMOTE CURRENT AND FUTURE VISITS TO OUR GREAT COUNTY.

COMMISSIONERS, YOU KNOW, AS DOES EVERYONE, THAT AN HONOREE MUST PAY A PRICE IN ORDER TO ATTAIN HONOR, AND IT HURTS DEEPLY TO MAKE THIS REQUEST, AS I HATE TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF YOUR GOOD AND BENEVOLENT NATURE, BUT YOU ARE THE GREATEST CHAMPIONS OF THE PEOPLE, AND THEIR MOST POPULAR LEADERS AND YOU KNOW WHAT, I HAVE LOST THE POINT OF ALL THIS. OK, YOU CAN BREATHE AGAIN. THE REQUEST IS SIMPLY, THAT YOU DONATE THE CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY TO BE KEPT IN THE CLUB HOUSE IN YOUR HONOR AND BECOME A PERMANENT RECORD OF THE WINNERS OF YOUR TOURNAMENT. IT IS WELL WORTH NOTING THAT AFTER BREAKING HIS OTHER ARM, THE CLERK OF THE COURTS HAS OFFERED TO DONATE THE SENIORS CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY.

TEE PLACEMENTS - Maximum distances - All Rounds.
Over 25 Years (MID-AMS) Blue Tees, 6750 yards.
Over 50 Years (SENIORS) White Tees, 6,450 yards.
SHORT FLIGHTS - May be evened out by drafting teams from another flight with awards adjusted accordingly.

FIRST DAY - Points will be earned/lost by each team member on each hole. The total points for a team will be determined and added to the total team handicap (80%). The first five teams will be given awards. Ties will be decided based on points by hole beginning at no. 5, except first place will be by playoff.

SECOND DAY - Twelve team flights will be organized separately for MID-AMS and seniors based on the points earned by the team on day one. Short flights may be augmented from a higher flight. Points will be earned by each team member on each hole. The total points for a team will be determined and the first three teams in each flight will be given awards. Ties for 1st place will be settled by playoff. All others will be decided based on points by hole beginning at no. 5.
