PROCLAMATION DESIGNATING OCTOBER 21-28, 1990 AS 1990 RED RIBBON
CAMPAIGN - OC-SOBERFEST 90'

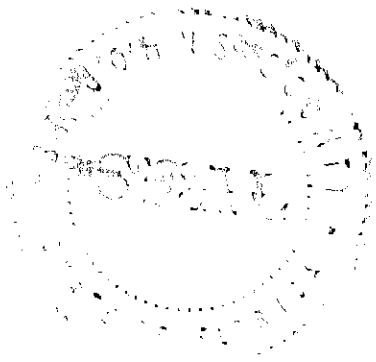
Whereas, alcohol and drug abuse have been responsible for the loss of livelihood and the loss of life in virtually every community in the nation; and

Whereas, October 21 - 28, 1990 has been designated National Red Ribbon Week, with President Bush and Mrs. Bush, as honorary chairs of the Campaign, calling on all Americans to show their support for a drug free nation by wearing a red ribbon during that week; and

Whereas, local leaders, in the government and in the community, know that the support of the people in the neighborhoods is the most effective weapon they can have in their efforts to reduce the demand for illegal drugs and drive away the suppliers of those drugs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that St. Johns County calls on its citizens to participate in the activities of the 1990 Red Ribbon Campaign, October 21 - 28 and to pledge to do their part to make the County of St. Johns a drug free community.
