

RESOLUTION 90-185

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATION UNDER THE HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION CENTER GRANT PROGRAM AND DIRECTING THE EXECUTION OF SAME BY THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation is accepting grant applications under the Hazardous Waste Collection Center Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, the said program will offer non-matching grants for prefabricated hazardous materials storage buildings and other associated costs, and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida desires to reduce to the greatest extent possible, the amount of hazardous materials entering the waste stream at the Tillman Ridge Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the said grant program will provide for the installation of hazardous waste storage facilities at the Tillman Ridge Landfill, thus providing the greater health and safety of St. Johns County residents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that the County Administrator is hereby directed to submit an application to the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation under the Hazardous Waste Collection Center Grant Program for the installation of storage facilities at the Tillman Ridge Landfill.
