

RESOLUTION NO. 90-188

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works of St. Johns County is responsible for the improvement and maintenance of all County Roads, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works had requested and received sealed bid proposals for a Pavement Management System that includes inspection services and software for analysis on 210 miles of County Roads for roadway evaluation training, systems training, reports (to be used in the evaluation of roads, sidewalks, curbs, drainage and guardrail conditions), the only response to this sealed bid was the Sole Bidder - Infrastructure Technology and bid was duly awarded by the Board, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has an additional requirement to extend the program for the same type of service from the above source for an additional 200 miles of County Roads, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the sole source requirements to extend the pavement management program and authorizes the County Administrator to extend said services from the sole source, Infrastructure Technology, Incorporated in the amount of \$29,300.00 as provided by Florida Law 81-843, paragraph (d) when goods, supplies and materials are available from one source.
