

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA PERTAINING TO
UNCLAIMED DEAD BODIES.

WHEREAS, Florida Statute §245.07 provides that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, upon notification from the Division of Universities that the Division has no need for an unclaimed dead body that died in St. Johns County, Florida and that is in the possession of the medical examiner's office, shall cause such body to be buried within the confines of the County,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that the County Administrator or his designee shall take all steps necessary pursuant to Chapter 245 Florida Statutes to cause said unclaimed dead body to be buried at county expense within the confines of the County.
