WHEREAS, the above named County Utility System is in the process of constructing a New Potable Water Treatment Plant that will ultimately support potable water requirements for current customers of Anastasia Sanitary District, Mainland Water System, and future customers for both systems, and

WHEREAS, certain specialized water processing equipment, ie; Item #1: Water Treatment Process Units, Item #2: Belt Filter Press and Item #3: High Service Pumps with Adjustable Speed Drives, as specified in the design by the Engineer for installation in the above mentioned Water Treatment Plant to be constructed can only be obtained from a single source,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the sole source requirements for above named equipment and authorizes the County Administrator to purchase said equipment from the sole source, for above Item #1 CBI, Walker Inc., Item #2 Ashbrook, Simon & Hartley, Inc. and Item #3 Carter and VerPlank, Inc., as provided by Florida Law 81-843, paragraph (d) when goods, supplies or materials are available from only one source.
