A RESOLUTION OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA MODIFYING AND ADDING CERTAIN FEES AND CHARGES PERTAINING TO GARBAGE AND REFUSE DISPOSAL ESTABLISHED BY ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 89-20 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on May 9, 1989, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida passed St. Johns County Ordinance No. 89-20; and

WHEREAS, Sections 37 and 38 of the Ordinance provided that the Board may modify and/or add to such fees and charges by Resolution (s);

NOW THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 13th day of March, 1990.

## SECTION 1.

The fees and charges established by Sections 37 (i) (ii) and 38.A (i) (ii) (iv) of St. Johns County Ordinance 89-20 are hereby modified and established, and shall be charged and collected as follows:

SECTION 37.

- (i) \$1.00 per tire for up to and including ten (10) tires per delivery.
- (ii) More than ten (10) tires delivered at the same time shall be disposed of only at the County landfill: \$100.00 per ton.

SECTION 38.

- A. Across Weigh Scales (Per Ton):
- (i) Packer Trucks, Roll-off Containers, Front-End Loaders and other vehicles and trailers not included or described in A(ii), A(iii), A(iv) below: \$28.00
  (ii) Horticultural Trash not included in B below: \$26.00
  (iii) Construction Debris not included in B below: \$20.00
  (iv) Sludge \$7.00
  (v) White Goods Per Item \$1.00
