

RESOLUTION NO. 90-7

Whereas there is some question as to whether the state public records law, particularly the provisions requiring copies of public records to be made for the actual cost of duplication, restricts a local government's ability to obtain a copyright and to license or sell government developed computer software for more than the actual cost of duplication; and

Whereas the Florida Local Government Data Processing Association has presented draft Bill # PCG GO 90-24; and

Whereas the Bill would authorize local governments, state agencies, and other governmental entities to copyright internally - created computer software and licenses or sell the software at market price; and

Whereas the software must be provided at no more than cost to persons using the software exclusively on data or information of the holder of the copyright; and

Whereas St. Johns County supports the Bill as presented by the Florida Local Government Data Processing Association

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida this 9th day of January, 1990, that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida notify the House Committee On Governmental Operations, Tallahassee, Florida, of the Board's support of the draft Bill and urge the Committee to act on said draft Bill and submit same to the House of Representatives.
