WHEREAS, Governor Bob Martinez has proposed a three (3) percent service charge on the One-Half Cent Tax Trust Fund; and a six (6) percent service charge on the Intangible Tax Trust Funds; and

WHEREAS, the County has already budgeted its full share of these trust funds for the current fiscal year ending September 30, 1990 and any reduction in these funds will have to be replaced by other revenue sources; and

WHEREAS, the County is mandated by the State to pay ever-increasing costs for local government operations; and

WHEREAS, continuous increases in assessments by the State on County generated revenues are causing revenue shortfalls in the County;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, do hereby:

Request that the local legislative delegation oppose the passage of House Bill 2917 and the Companion Sentate Bill 582 which would allow the State to assess service charges on local government trust funds;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners direct the St. Johns County Clerk of Court to provide the Governor and each member of the local legislative delegation with a copy of this resolution.
