

RESOLUTION NO. 91-106

RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, in the County Auditorium of the St. Johns County Administration Building, on August 13, 1991, at 9:00 o'clock a.m. upon petition of qualified land owners, will consider the advisability of exercising the power granted to it by Section 336.09, Florida Statutes 1985, and determine whether it will vacate, abandon, discontinue and close portions of certain streets, alleyways or roads described as follows:

and the notice required by Section 336.10, Florida Statutes 1985, is hereby authorized and directed to be published.

Further, notice of the time, date, and place of the public hearing shall be promptly mailed by certified mail - return receipt requested, to each of the persons and entities at their addresses as described in Title Opinion dated June 25, 1991

The petitioner shall perform such mailings and shall provide the Clerk with proof of same five days before the scheduled hearing date.

SCHEDULE "A"

All that part or portion of Hill Street (a 30 foot street) which lies between Lot 1, Block 2, San Sebastian Subdivision, a portion of vacated Cordova Avenue, as recorded in Map Book 3, page 32, public records of St. Johns County, Florida, and Lot 10 in Block 6, the Northerly portion of Lot 10 in Block 6, and a portion of vacated Cordova Avenue, as recorded in Map Book 1, page 134, public records of St. Johns County, Florida, and between the South right-of-way line of Covina Avenue and the North right-of-way line of State Road 16.
