WHEREAS, an off duty Jacksonville firefighter, Mr. Reggie Thompson, witnessed the accident and returned to the scene and successfully rescued two teenagers from the burning car while a third teenager with minor injuries was able to crawl from the wreckage; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Thompson, in removing the two teenagers from the car, sustained a serious hand laceration when smashing the windshield, cutting the seat belts and dragging the teenagers to safety, and

WHEREAS, a secondary explosion intensifying the fire prevented rescue attempts of the occupants of the pickup; and

WHEREAS, had it not been for Mr. Thompson's efforts in pulling the two young people to safety seconds before their car exploded into flames they would have been killed;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County hereby acknowledges that Mr. Reggie Thompson displayed outstanding bravery and courage while risking extreme personal injury and danger. The Board of County Commissioners further commends and recognizes Mr. Thompson for his heroism in saving the lives of two people in St. Johns County on August 3, 1991.

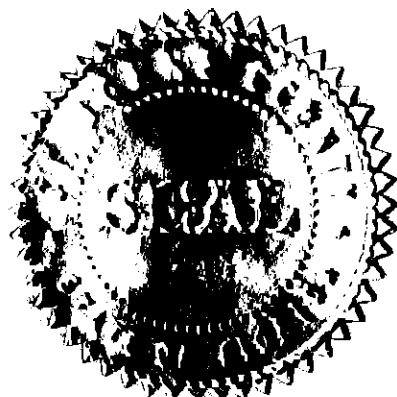
