WHEREAS, St. Augustine/St. Johns County has a rich and unique architectural heritage; and,

WHEREAS, the Florida Bureau of Historic Preservation makes available "Special Category Funding" dollars for historic preservation; and,

WHEREAS, application has been made for "Special Category Funding" for four projects in St. Augustine/St. Johns County: The St. Augustine Lighthouse, The Segui-Kirby Smith House, Alcazar Hotel, and Flagler College; and,

WHEREAS, these four projects have been recommended for approval by the Florida Bureau of Historic Preservation Advisory Council; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes that this unique heritage belongs to all the citizens of the U.S.A.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, encourages the Florida Legislature to continue the flow of "Special Category Funding" dollars; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we urge approval of The St. Augustine Lighthouse, The Segui-Kirby Smith House, Alcazar Hotel, and Flagler College for funding with "Special Category Funding" preservation dollars.
