

RESOLUTION NO. 91-19

A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR
EXPANDED LOCAL CALLING AREA

WHEREAS, The Northeast corner of St. Johns County is experiencing rapid growth and,

WHEREAS, the local telephone exchange calling patterns prevent calling to the remainder of the County without the expense of long distance charges, and

WHEREAS, the calling scope also restricts contact with county government agencies with a local call, and

WHEREAS, economic development in St. Johns County will be deterred in the future without improved local calling arrangement, and

WHEREAS, a major objective of St. Johns County is to encourage economic development and to enhance the quality of life in our county,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that our Public Service Commission be respectfully requested to undertake a study of our local calling area leading to an offering of an improved local calling arrangement between Northeast St. Johns County and St. Augustine.
