## RESOLUTION NO. 91-47

WHEREAS, Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida pursued the placement of a landfill site (Jacksonville "Southeast" Landfill) that borderd on the County of St. Johns; and

WHEREAS, the proposed landfill site was not compatable with the Comprehensive Plan of St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, the proposed landfill site was approximately one
(1) mile from a major Junior-Senior High School of St. Johns
County; and

WHEREAS, the proposed landfill site was environmentally extremely sensitive; and

whereas, the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners and the citizens of St. Johns County were totally opposed to the proposed landfill site; and

WHEREAS, for these and other reasons the permitting and placement of a landfill project on the border with St. Johns County was contrary to the public interest; and

WHEREAS, Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida had other more suitable potential landfill site alternatives; and

WHEREAS, on February 12, 1991 the Governor of Florida, Lawton Chiles, and his Cabinet in their wisdom voted to deny the placement of a landfill on the borders of St. Johns County.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners wishes to express its sincere thanks and gratitude to Governor Chiles and the Cabinet of the State of Florida for denying the Jacksonville "Southeast" landfill project.
