WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida by Resolution 87-10 adopted January 13, 1987, appointed Wendell Powell as a member of the St. Johns County Industrial Development Authority for a term of four years; and

WHEREAS, the term of Wendell Powell as a member of the St. Johns County Industrial Development Authority was scheduled to expire on January 22, 1991 and he has indicated his desire not to be reappointed to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida by Resolution #89-25 adopted January 24, 1989 appointed Fred Brinkhoff as a member of the St. Johns County Industrial Development Authority for a term of four years; and

WHEREAS, in November 1990, Fred Brinkhoff was elected to the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, and as a result, has announced his resignation from the St. Johns County Industrial Development Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby accepts the resignation of Fred Brinkhoff from the St. Johns County Industrial Development Authority and publicly expresses its deep appreciation for the hard and productive work that both Fred Brinkhoff and Wendell Powell have contributed to the St. Johns County Industrial Development Authority.

Section 2. It is hereby found that David J. Bruner II and Donald R. Tully are residents and electors of St. Johns County.

Section 3. David J. Bruner II is hereby appointed as a member of the St. Johns County Industrial Development Authority and he shall serve from the date hereof to January 22, 1993 and until his successor is appointed and has qualified.

Section 4. <u>Donald R. Tully</u> is hereby appointed as a member of the St. Johns County Industrial Development Authority and he shall serve until January 22, 1995 and until his successor is appointed and has qualified.

Section 5. Said members shall take and subscribe their oath or affirmation required by the state constitution and a record of such oaths shall be filed with the Department of State and with the Clerk.
