

RESOLUTION NO. 92-111

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT ESTABLISHES A GEOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION COORDINATING COMMITTEE AND DEFINES ITS PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the Geographic Information Systems (GIS) are conceived to manage geographical information; and allows the user to do analytical analysis based on spacial relationships using data based technology; GIS has such a powerful future for governmental application that it should become a household word for all those in leadership positions and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, and especially St. Johns County are in a period of rapid growth demands for geographical infrastructure information demands that cannot be met with the outdated and uncoordinated methods of information, storage and retrieval that have been used in the past; and

WHEREAS, one of the most important considerations in building a geographical information system is being able to add layers of data at a future date which is time consuming and cost prohibitive if done all at once.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County that:

Section 1. A Committee is created consisting of a County Commissioner or designee, the Property Appraiser or designee, the Sheriff or designee, the Supervisor of Elections or designee, the County Administrator or designee, and the County Engineer.

Section 2. Purpose of the Committee is to guide and direct the development, installation, maintenance and operation of a geographical information system for St. John County, including financial recommendations to perform this program.
