A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF THE TREASURE BEACH CANAL NON AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT LEVIED PURSUANT TO ST. JOHNS COUNTY ORDINANCE 91-47, AS AMENDED, AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL NON AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT ROLL PERTAINING THERETO.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida as follows:

The rate or amount of the Treasure Beach Canal Section 1. non ad valorem special assessment levied pursuant to St. Johns County ordinance 91-47, as amended, is hereby established and set principal at the total rate (amount) of \$ 1,726.80 (plus interest at 7.5 % per year on the unpaid balance) for each lot (the "unit of measurement") described in the ordinance. This total special assessment shall be applied and charged at the yearly rate of \$ 250.00 per lot per year (which yearly rate includes interest) for 10 consecutive years commencing November 1992 and will be collected each of those 10 years pursuant to Florida Statute 197.3632 in the manner and at the times that ad valorem taxes are collected. The unpaid principal balance plus any accrued interest may be paid in full at the option of the lot owner prior to the due date of the last scheduled installment.

Section 2. The non ad valorem assessment roll attached hereto is hereby adopted as the St. Johns County Treasure Beach Canal non ad valorem assessment roll. The amount of the rates shown therein shall be controlled by this resolution as it may be amended from time to time.

Section 3. By September 15, 1992 and by September 15 each year thereafter, the County Administrator shall certify the Treasure Beach Canal non ad valorem assessment roll, with such additions and deletions each year as are appropriate, on compatible electronic medium to the St. Johns County tax collector with the dollar amount of the Treasure Beach Canal non ad valorem assessment due that year for each parcel posted thereon.


