RESOLUTION NO. 92-169

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING AN APPEAL PROCEDURE FROM ADMINISTRATIVE DECISIONS OF STAFF IN DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PARTIAL PAYMENT PROGRAM FOR RESIDENTIAL IMPACT FEES ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCES NO. 92-21, 92-22, 92-23 AND 92-24.

WHEREAS, Ordinances No. 92-21, 92-22, 92-23 and 92-24 established the terms and conditions under which citizens may qualify for the program; and

WHEREAS, said ordinances have no procedure for an appeal from such action as may be taken with respect to eligibility.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners that the County Administrator is hereby authorized to hear such appeals, when presented to him in written form and to make the determination as to eligibility using the same parameters as set forth in Ordinances No. 92-21, 92-22, 92-23 and 92-24.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners may consider any appeals from the decision of the County Administrator and make the final determination on this matter.
