A RESOLUTION FINDING THAT A PUBLIC PURPOSE IS SERVED BY THE PERFORMANCE OF THE GREAT AMERICAN CIRCUS IN ST. JOHNS COUNTY IN NOVEMBER 1992 AS SPONSORED BY THE SERTOMA CLUB WITH A PORTION OF THE PROCEEDS TO BE USED FOR TOYS FOR TOTS AND AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF THE NECESSARY ST. JOHNS COUNTY OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE FEE FOR SUCH PERFORMANCE FROM THE COUNTY GENERAL FUND.

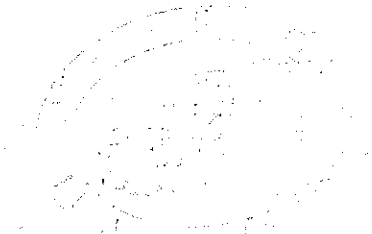

Section 1. It is hereby found and determined that a public purpose is served by the performance of the Great American Circus in St. Johns County in November, 1992 as sponsored by the Sertoma Club with a portion of the proceeds to be used for Toys for Tots.

Section 2. County staff is hereby authorized and directed to cause the payment for the St. Johns County
