A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA SUPPORTING THE CONTINUING OPERATION OF THE MAYPORT FERRY

WHEREAS, the Mayport Ferry has served as a means of transporting people across the St. Johns River for over forty years; and

WHEREAS, the Mayport Ferry remains a valuable link between Mayport, one of the oldest fishing communities in the nation and Fort George Island, both of significant historical interest to tourists; and

WHEREAS, State Road AIA is a continuous road along the entire coast of Florida and the Mayport Ferry is an important segment transporting more than a quarter of a million automobiles annually; and

WHEREAS, the Mayport Ferry is an integral part of the First Coast area,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida requests the Florida Department of Transportation to continue funding this important road link in the First Coast.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Court is instructed to send a copy of this resolution to the Florida Department of Transportation, Mayor of the City of Jacksonville and the Northeast Florida Regional Planning Council.
