m OF}$ COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA REAFFIRMING THE NEED FOR THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND REAFFIRMING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' SUPPORT FOR THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES ADVISORY COMMITTEE; AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 88-180, WHICH ESTABLISHES THE HUMAN SERVICES ADVISORY COMMITTEE, BY ADDING A REQUIREMENT THAT THE HEALTH AND HUMAN BY ADDING SERVICES ADVISORY COMMITTEE REVIEW FUNDING REQUESTS FROM CERTAIN AGENCIES WITHIN ST. JOHNS COUNTY AND PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE REQUESTS TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 88-180, the Board of County COmmissioners of St. Johns County, Florida (the "Board") established the Human Services Advisory Committee, and acknowledged the following:

Government cannot and should not attempt to solve all social problems;

Government has demonstrated concern for and sensitivity to the problems of the community; and

It is desirable to address problems of the community and to seek solutions and remedies in order to preserve and promote the health, safety and welfare of citizens.

WHEREAS, subsequently, on July 23, 1991, the Board approved changing the name of the Human Services Advisory Committee to the Health and Human Services Advisory Committee; and,

WHEREAS, the Board wishes at this time to reaffirm the establishment of the Health and Human Services Advisory Committee and to reaffirm its full and continuing support for the Committee and its work; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes at this time to supplement the rules and directives adopted in Resolution No. 88-180 for the Health and Human Services Advisory Committee by requiring the Health and Human Services Advisory Committee to review funding requests from certain agencies within the County, as identified below and provide recommendations relative to those requests for County funds.

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida hereby reaffirms the establishment of the Health and Human Services Advisory Committee and expresses its full and continuing support for the Committee and its intention to implement the rules and directives established for the Committee in Resolution No. 88-180.

Section 2. Paragraph 3 of Resolution No. 88-180, identifying Committee functions, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

- g. Receive and review requests for funding and provide recommendations relative to those requests to the Board for funding the following agencies:
- Family Medical and Dental Centers;
- 2) United Child Care;
- 3) Northeast Florida Community Action Agency;
- 4) Association for Retarded Citizens, St. Johns;
- 5) St. Johns County Council On Aging;
- 6) Retired Senior Volunteer Program;
- 7) Childbirth and Parenting Education Association;
- 8) Deaf and Hearing Impaired Service Center;
- 9) St. Johns County Welfare Federation;
- 10) County Health Department Primary Care Program;
- 11) Other Health or Human Service Agencies which might apply for funding from St. Johns County.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
