A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA PERTAINING TO ORDINANCE DRAFTING BY THE COUNTY LEGAL DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida (the "Board") wishes to utilize its attorneys' time in an efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, THE Board's attorneys have, in the past, been requested by Board members, County staff, and/or members of the public to draft complicated ordinances pertaining to subject matter that the majority of the Board does not wish to regulate or to address by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the drafting of such ordinances by the Board's attorneys reduces the amount of attorney time that should be used to address the legal issues of the County

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA that the St. Johns County legal department is instructed not to spend County time to draft or review proposed County ordinances without the prior verbal approval of the Board of County Commissioners or its Chairman (or in the Chairman's absence, its Vice Chairman).
