RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA STATING ITS INTENT TO DELETE A SEGMENT OF POWELL ROAD FROM THE ROADS TO BE PAVED AS PART OF THE "THOMPSON-BAILEY ROAD" MUNICIPAL SERVICE BENEFIT UNIT (THE MSBU) PROJECT AS ALLOWED BY ORDINANCE NO. 91-51 SECTION 2 PARAGRAPH E.

DELETE A SEGMENT OF POWELL ROAD FROM THE ROADS TO BE PAVED AS PART OF THE THOMPSON-BAILEY ROAD "MSBU" PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners determined at its meeting of December 12, 1991 that the paving of a certain segment of Powell Road as described below is not necessary for any public purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As allowed by ordinance 91-51 the following segment of Powell Road more particularly described as follows shall not be paved as part of the MSBU project.


