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PROJECT NARRATIVE

- Description of Proposed Project:
 Replacement of 4,000 SF of damaged boat ramp.
- 2. Statement of the Applicants Justification for the Construction of the Proposed Project: The major portion of work of dredging the boat basin and constructing a new channel is underway. This work is necessary to complete the project for boat launching accessing the ICCW.
- Reasoning Why FIND Should Support this Project: FIND originally funded Engineering Studies that were performed to evaluate and design a course of action to rectify maintenance problems at the site. St. Johns County is committed to complete this project.
- 4. Statement of the Direct Relationship of the Project to the Waterway:

 The project provides immediate access to the Intercoastal Waterway and is the only major public boat launching facility in St. Johns County.
- 5. Statement of the Direct Relationship of the Project to the Maintenance of the Waterways: The aforementioned studies in # 3 above were performed to reduce maintenance at this site providing the general public better access to the waterways. This project is the final phase for providing suitable access.
- 6. Statement of the Projects Benefit to Public Navigation in the District Waterways: Ramp is being redesigned to prevent failure occurring from prop wash. Failure has caused ramp separation. Ramp repairs are intended to prevent damaging boat trailers.
- 7. Statement of Potential Public Usage of the Project. The current closing of this facility has had a significant impact on other facilities providing great awareness of how important the Vilano Site is needed. No less than 200 boats daily are having to relocate to other launching sites with excessive overcrowding.
