

RESOLUTION NO. 92-96

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOHNS, STATE OF FLORIDA, SETTING A HEARING TO CONSIDER THE ADVISABILITY OF VACATING AND DETERMINING WHETHER IT WILL VACATE (1) A PORTION OF HENRY STREET LYING IMMEDIATELY SOUTH OF LOTS 1 AND 2, BLOCK 3, ROTHSCILDS ADDITION; AND (2) A PORTION OF UNNAMED ALLEY LYING IMMEDIATELY NORTH OF LOTS 1 AND 2, BLOCK 3, ROTHSCILDS ADDITION, BOTH AS MORE FULLY DESCRIBED BELOW.

RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, in the County Auditorium of the St. Johns County Administration Building, on July 14, 1992, at 9:00 o'clock a.m. upon petition of qualified land owners, will consider the advisability of exercising the power granted to it by Section 336.09, Florida Statutes 1985, and determine whether it will vacate, abandon, discontinue and close portions of certain streets, alleyways or roads described as follows:

Legal description as per attached "Schedule A" and the notice required by Section 336.10, Florida Statutes 1985, is hereby authorized and directed to be published.

Further, notice of the time, date and place of the public hearing shall be promptly mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to each of the persons and entities at their addressed as described in SCHEDULE "B", search # _____, attached to the Petition to Vacate.

The petitioner shall perform such mailings and shall provide the Clerk with proof of same five days before the scheduled hearing date.

SCHEDULE "A"

(1) Re: Portion of Alleyway

That portion of that unnamed 12 foot alley lying immediately north of Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 (not vacated by BCC Resolution No. 84-96), Block 3, Rothschilds Addition, as per Map Book 3, Page 133, of the public records of St. Johns County, Florida, excepting therefrom that portion of the subject property lying within the right-of-way of S.R. No. 5-A as now established.

(2) Re: Portion of Henry Street

That portion of Henry Street, an unopened subdivision street, which is 50 feet wide, lying immediately south of Lots 1 and 2, Blk. 3, Rothschilds Addition, as per Map Book 3, page 133, of the public records of St. Johns County, Florida, excepting therefrom that portion of the subject property lying within the right-of-way of S.R. No. 5-A as now established.
