**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROCLAIMING THE MONTH
OF AUGUST AS JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ACT
ALUMNI MONTH**

WHEREAS, the federally funded Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA), administered by the Northeast Florida Private Industry Council, Inc., is an effective program for assisting school dropouts, welfare recipients, unskilled adults, displaced homemakers, dislocated workers and others who face serious barriers to employment; and

WHEREAS, the Northeast Florida Private Industry Council, Inc., coordinates training and employment programs in Baker, Clay, Nassau, Putnam and St. Johns counties with JTPA funds; and
