RESOLUTION OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RECOGNIZING THE DILIGENT EFFORTS OF VOLUNTEERS AND VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTERS AND THEIR CONTRIBUTION TO THE COMMUNITY DURING THE WEEKEND STORM OF MARCH 12, 1993.

WHEREAS, the citizens of St. Johns County experienced severe weather on the weekend of March 12, 1993 and many citizens experienced significant losses due to the storm; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County was fortunate not to suffer the loss of lives or extensive damage other Counties in the Nation experienced; and
