A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT THAT AN ANNUAL APPLICATION BE MADE FOR AGRICULTURAL CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY AFTER AN INITIAL APPLICATION IS MADE AND THE CLASSIFICATION GRANTED.

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 193.461(3)(a) allows a county at the request of the Property Appraiser and by a majority vote of the governing body to waive the requirement that an annual application or statement be made for the agricultual classification of property within the county after an initial application is made and the agricultural classification granted;

WHEREAS, Allen F. Powers is the duly elected Property

Appraiser for St. Johns County, and has requested the Board

of County Commissioners to waive such requirement in

accordance with Florida Statute 193.461(3)(a);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

The requirement that an annual application or statement be made for the agricultural classification of property is waived after an initial application is made and the agricultural classification is granted. This waiver is effective for the tax year beginning on January 1, 1994, and each year thereafter.
